# 1. <u>Step 1:</u>

• Download Extension and place inside your Project root/app/code/

# 2. <u>Step 2:</u>

In magento root directory run the following commands using the command line:

- php bin/magento setup:upgrade
- php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy

## 3. <u>Step 3:</u>

To access this extension in your site domain, you must need to register your domain.
